



## Revision to A Guide to Service Scouting

The following change have been brought to the Rover Scout Progressive Scheme / Guide to Service Scouting.

<b>Service Training Star</b>	
<b>Current Text</b>	It is worn on both epaulettes above the project badge and is granted by the Association on the recommendation of the SSL. Before being awarded the service training star, a Service Scout just give six months service with a group at least as an assistant unit leader, to the satisfaction of the Association and the GSM of the concerned Troop or Pack.
<b>Amended Text</b>	The Service Star is awarded by the Scout Group on the recommendation of the Rover Advisor on the following conditions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A Rover Scout should serve a Scout Group as a Young Leader for a duration of 6 months to the satisfaction of the Group Scout Leader.</li> </ul>
<b>Scout Craft Star</b>	
<b>Current Text</b>	Scout Craft Star is worn on both epaulettes above the Rambler's badge, and is granted by the Association on the recommendation of the SSL, on the following conditions:  Hold a warrant as a Pack or Unit Leader and have served at least six months after the training to qualify for the star  OR  Have camped at least 10 separate occasions aggregating not less than 10 nights on three different camp sites and comply strictly with Camping Standards. He must keep a log of these camps and submit to the SSL, be



	<p>competent to instruct and examine a senior scout in any two of the following badges - Dispatch Rider, Master swimmer, Quartermaster, Senior pioneer. Master cook.( He need not necessarily act as an examiner in the badges selected)</p>
<p><b>Amended Text</b></p>	<p>The Scout Craft Star is awarded by the Scout Group on the recommendation of the Rover Advisor on the following conditions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A Rover Scout should serve a Scout Group as a Young Leader for a duration of 6 months to the satisfaction of the Group Scout Leader. Should be different from the duration served to earn the Service Training Star.</li> </ul> <p style="text-align: center;">OR</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Have camped at least 10 separate occasions aggregating not less than 10 nights on three different camp sites and comply strictly with Camping Standards. He must keep a log of these camps and submit to the Rover Advisor.</li> <li>• Be competent to instruct and examine a Scout in any 2 of the following proficiency badges: Advance Pioneer, Advance Swimmer, Quartermaster and Camp Cook.</li> </ul>

**Young Leaders:** are young people who are developing and delivering the Youth Programme to younger age-sections or are involved in supporting other adults or organizational structures. In this case “leader” is related to the role they play on behalf of the organization<sup>1</sup>.
