



National Cub Scout Rally and Pre-Cub Meet – Male' Area

The National Cub Scout Rally and Pre-Cub Meet is organized by the Scout Association of Maldives for youth members; Pre-Cubs (5 – 8 years) and Cub Scouts (8 – 12 years). Both these age groups represent more than half of the current membership of the Association. The event organized in Male' Area for both sections is open for all invested Pre-Cubs and Cub Scouts in Greater Male' Area and close by islands.

Cub Scout Rally is a one-day event organized by the Scout Association of Maldives to bring together Cub Scouts from different Scout Groups providing an opportunity to engage in a fun filled learning experience.

Objectives of the National Cub Scout Rally

- Provide the opportunity for Cub Scouts to engage in Scout craft activities
- Provide new learning experience through interactions with external partners (Community groups, civil societies etc)
- Provide the opportunity to engage in learning by doing.

Pre-Cub Meet is an activity organized by the Scout Association of Maldives to bring together the youngest members of the Association to a fun filled evening, providing new experiences and interactions with other pre-cubs from different Scout Groups.

Venue and Date

The event is planned to be held on the 21st of January 2023. The proposed venue of the event is Hulhumale' (Phase 1)

- Cub Rally will be held from 09:00 – 18:00hrs
- Pre-Cub Meet will be held from 14:00 – 18:00hrs

Who can take part?

Cub Rally is open for all Cub Scouts who have completed their Cub Scout Bronze Award. All Youth Members of the Pre-Cub Section can attend the Meet.

All participating Scout Groups should register with the Scout Association of Maldives by submitting the registration form (including the excel file attachment) by 20:00hrs Thursday, 12th January 2023 to the Scout Association of Maldives. (Form shared with the Circular)

Scout Groups must ensure that every 10 participant is accompanied by 1 Adult Leader. Groups that do not meet this requirement on registration will not be able to take part in the event. The Scout Groups is responsible for all their participants.

Participation Fee:

All participating Scout Groups are required to pay:

- For Cub Scouts: MVR 100/- (both for the Cub Scout and Adult Leaders)
- For Pre-Cubs: MVR60/- (both for the Pre-Cub and Adult Leaders)

The Scout Association of Maldives will send an invoice all participating Scout Groups based on the submitted participation form.

Water and Food.

Drinking water will be available at the activity sites. Refillable water bottles are advised to be used. These bottles can be refilled at the activity sites. Food arrangements must be made by the participating Scout Groups.

What to bring:

- Scout Groups are requested to ensure that each participant bring his/her own refillable water bottle and cap.
- All participants are required to take part in the event in their Uniform.
- Each Scout Group should bring their Group Scout Flag to the Cub Rally.
- Each participant is required to bring a plain collarless T-shirt (either a white, grey, orange or yellow) for Screen printing activity.
- Each participant is required to bring a Sarong, Feyli or a long pants / trouser for prayers.

Programme

Cub Rally

The Cub Rally activities will be divided into 4 Activity Zones. Several exciting activities will be available for participants in Each Zone. Participants are expected to complete at least 2 activities from each zone. An activity card will be provided to each participating Cub Scout.

The following Zones will be set up at the Cub Rally.

- Cultural Zone
- Art and Craft Zone
- Community Zone
- Adventure Zone

Each activity will be a 20 – 30 minutes skills building and/or learning workshop. Adventure Zone will include activities that participants can enjoy and test their physical potential.

Pre-Cub Meet

Pre-Cubs taking part in the meet will be able to take part in all activities offered at the Cub Rally event as well, however, pre-cubs are not mandatory to complete full skill building and/or learning workshops. At each zone there would be some activity stalls that are dedicated for pre-cubs as well.

Participation Certificate and Badge

Each participant will be provided with a Certificate and an event Badge by the Scout Association of Maldives.
