Venue and reporting times:

The National Cub Rally and Pre-Cub Meet will take place on Saturday, 21st January 2023. Event base will be Ghaazee School and Mohamed Qasim Preschool, Hulhumale'. Activities will be held in Ruhgandu 02 open area and Central Park area. Rally ground will be the open space in front of Ghaazee School.

Reporting Time:

All Youth Members accompanied by Adult Members should report to the event base by reporting time.

- Cub Scouts 09:00hrs
- Pre-Cubs 14:00hrs

On-site registration:

At each event base registration desks will be set up by the Scout Association of Maldives. One Leader from each Scout Group is requested to come to the registration desk to collect activity cards and confirm participant attendance.

Programme

Cub Scout Rally:

Each Scout Group will be required to divide their Cub Scouts into Activity Groups of 25 participants. Please find attached below Information Sheet the number of Activity Groups each Scout Group is required to divide their Cub Scouts into. Scout Groups must ensure that adequate Leaders and helpers are assigned to each Activity Group.

Activity Groups will be assigned to event locations at the beginning of the day and movement plan for groups along with a list of stalls in each area will be shared at the registration desk to the Scout Group.

Each Activity Group will spend at least 15-20 minutes in each activity station/stall. After completing each station / stall participants are required to get a Stamp/Sign on their activity cards.

What to bring:

- Scout Groups are requested to ensure that each participant bring his/her own refillable water bottle and cap.
- All participants are required to take part in the event in their Uniform. (In accordance with the Uniform Policy of the Scout Association of Maldives, Tennis Shoes can be worn instead of the official black shoes.)
- Each participant is required to bring a plain collarless T-shirt (either a white, grey, orange or yellow) for Screen printing activity.
- Each participant is required to bring a Sarong, Feyli or a long pants / trouser for prayers.
- Participants can bring a notebook to the event. It is recommended not to bring additional items. Participants can carry a light bag with them to keep their prayer kit, refillable water bottle, notebook and pens/pencils.
