<b>Background</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- The Congress will convene more than 400 participants to shape the future of education in Scouting and advance non-formal education as a powerful vehicle for child and youth development.</li><li>- Through various plenary and breakout sessions, as well as informal spaces for networking, participants will have the opportunity to explore key themes in non-formal education related to youth leadership, education for sustainable development, intercultural engagements, intergenerational partnerships, and digital citizenship.</li><li>- Participants will also be able to learn about how to modernise their Youth Programme for the next generation, discover how to integrate the Scouts for SDGs educational initiatives into their national Scouting programmes, and hear from external partners about the latest trends in the fields of education and youth development.</li><li>- The 4th World Scout Education Congress, hosted by Scoutisme Français, builds on the successes of three past events held in Hong Kong (2013), Kandersteg (2017), and Rio de Janeiro (2019), and continues to advance an agenda for non-formal education outlined in the Rio Declaration, which was an outcome of the 2019 World Non-Formal Education Forum.</li></ul>
